

SITE RULES FOR TARONG POWER STATION AND WIVENHOE POWER STATION



1. You must wear your Identification Card at all times and make it available for inspection upon request. You must not allow any other person to use your Identification Card. Misplaced Identification Cards must be reported to Site Security immediately. Identification Cards must be returned to Site Security at the conclusion of your work on Site.
2. If you are performing work on Site, you must be appropriately qualified to perform the work. You must ensure you hold all relevant licences and prescribed occupation certificates for the work.
3. You must report to your supervisor or Tarong Energy representative on a daily basis.
4. You must wear high visibility clothing and other appropriate, properly maintained personal protective equipment (PPE), including carrying gloves, at all times.
5. You must do all things reasonably practicable to protect your own health and safety and the health and safety of others. You must immediately report all work related injuries, illnesses and incidents (including near miss incidents) to your supervisor or Tarong Energy Representative and complete appropriate incident report forms.
6. You must do all things reasonably practicable to protect the environment and prevent environmental harm. You must ensure materials and wastes are stored securely and any spills are adequately contained and cleaned up immediately. You must not hose waste or spills down drains. You must not clear vegetation or disturb soil unless you have Tarong Energy approval. You must store and dispose of your waste in accordance with the Waste Management Handbook for the Site. You must immediately report any environmental incident or near miss to your supervisor or Tarong Energy Representative and complete appropriate incident report forms.
7. You must not smoke in any enclosed area, in any area where food is being prepared or consumed, in any designated "No Smoking" area or within 4 metres of the entrance to a building.
8. You must be in a fit condition to work. You must not be impaired by alcohol or drugs while on Site. With cause and random testing is conducted at all Tarong Energy Sites.
9. You must at all times behave in an appropriate manner and refrain from abusive, aggressive, violent, discriminatory, offensive or inflammatory conduct.
10. You must not damage or deface any plant, buildings or paintwork.
11. You must not enter any of the Control Rooms, Relay Rooms, Computer Rooms, Switchrooms or other restricted access areas on Site without the express permission of Tarong Energy.
12. You must not remove from Site any item that is the property of Tarong Energy or any third party without the written consent of the owner of the relevant item.
13. If you are authorised to drive a vehicle on Site, you must exercise due care and attention when driving and adhere to all applicable road signs (including signs indicating maximum speeds). Seat belts must be worn in moving vehicles. Vehicles must be parked only in designated car parks or other authorised areas.
14. While you are on Site, you must remain in your designated work area, unless otherwise authorised.
15. You must not interfere with Tarong Energy's principal operations and must fully cooperate with Tarong Energy employees and any contractors working on Site.
16. You must comply with all directions given by Tarong Energy. You may be stopped and questioned by Site security or a Tarong Energy employee and may be required to explain the nature of your attendance on Site or your presence in a particular area of the Site.
17. You must not take any photographs, digital images or video footage of the Site or areas within the Site unless you have the prior approval of Tarong Energy.
18. Areas of the Site may be monitored by cameras. You must not interfere with any cameras or other recording equipment used by Tarong Energy at the Site.
19. You must not bring any firearm or explosive device onto the Site. You must not bring any hazardous substance or dangerous goods onto the Site, unless you have prior approval.
20. Vehicles and toolboxes brought onto Site may be searched.
21. If at any time Tarong Energy withdraws its consent for you to enter or be at the Site, you must immediately return your Identification Card to Site Security and leave the Site.
