



Am I eligible to apply for the Apprentice and Trainee Program?

You will need to meet the below criteria to be eligible to apply for the Apprentice and Trainee Program:

- + Permanent resident or Australian/New Zealand citizen as at the date of application
- + Currently completing or have recently completed a minimum of year 10 or equivalent
- + Willing to commence full time work from February the following year



Will I have my uniforms supplied?

All of your uniforms and personal protective equipment will be supplied by Stanwell.

To whom should I address my application?

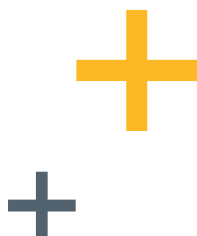
You can address your application to the Stanwell People and Culture Team.
